Lieutenant-Governor of the Province of South Australia and the Dependencies
thereof, &c., &c., &c.

THE MEMORIAL OF *Hans Peter Olesen*, of
Murra in the Province of South Australia,

Humbly Sheweth—

THAT your Memorialist is an Alien, being a native of *Shadst*
in *Denmark*
of the age of *39*

years, and by profession, trade, or occupation, a *salting labourer*
that he has resided in South Australia for the space of
sixteen years and is desirous of becoming a permanent
settler in the said Province.

That your Memorialist now seeks to obtain the rights and capacities of a natural-born
British subject, in conformity with the provisions of the "Aliens Act, 1864," and hereby
offers evidence of the allegations and grounds of this Memorial: to wit—the certificate at
the foot hereof.

Your Memorialist, therefore, humbly prays that your Excellency may be graciously
pleased to grant your Memorialist Letters of Naturalization, in conformity with the
provisions of the said Act.
