

PETITION FOR DIVORCE.

In the Civil Court before Mr. Justice Puckle on Monday, the hearing was resumed of the petition brought by H. J. D. Longwill for a dissolution of his marriage with A. H. Longwill on the ground of the misconduct of the latter with Harold Edeson, of Victoria. At the previous hearing the case was adjourned to enable the petitioner to call additional evidence. Mr. L. David Waterhouse represented the petitioner. Evidence in support of the petition was given by Mrs. Matilda Matheson, of Millcent. His Honor found the allegation of misconduct proved, and pronounced a decree nisi. The co-respondent was ordered to pay the costs.
