INSTRUCTIONS.

1. This Pay Book must be produced on demand.
2. When any pay is drawn a receipt must be given by the soldier on an Acquittance Roll and the Officer paying will enter the amount and sign on the "Cash Payments" page of this pay book. The Pay Book No. and the Cash Payments No. must be shown on the Acquittance Roll against the payment.
3. All debits other than pay must be entered and signed by an authorised Officer on the "Cash Payments" page.
4. Forfeitures of pay must be calculated at full rates, less deferred, and entered on the "Cash Payments" page.
5. No entries will be made in this book by the person to whom it is issued, except to sign on pages 2 and 4, and to make a Will, if so desired, on page 19.
6. If this pay book is lost, the fact should be reported AT ONCE through the O.C. to the Staff Paymaster, A.I.F., London, who will issue a duplicate pay book. No pay can be issued (until final settlement takes place) in respect of the period before the date of reporting the loss.
7. **IMPORTANT.**—In every case when payment is made to men "In the Field" these three words will be the only entry made in the column headed "Place."







DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE.

LEAVE GRATUITY FOR WAR SERVICE.

1. A Leave Gratuity on the undermentioned scale and subject to the conditions stated below has been approved for payment to all Members of the Australian Imperial Force and the Naval and Military Expeditionary Force who have served abroad for a period of at least ten months and have been discharged without receiving a special grant of leave and sustenance allowance for the period to which they are entitled under the scale. No amount of sustenance allowance is payable unless a member has served abroad for a longer period than twelve months.

2. "Service abroad" extends from date of embarkation in Australia until date of disembarkation on return.

3. The scale is calculated on the following basis:—

Pay.—

- (a) $7\frac{1}{2}$ days' leave with pay of rank at time of discharge for each six months' service abroad.
- (b) Service for a period of less than six months but exceeding four months counts as six months.
- (c) An odd half day in the total amount of leave is considered a full day.
- (d) A deduction of a uniform period of 14 days has been made from the full number of days' leave to which a member is entitled as above for his period of service abroad. This deduction is on account of leave on full pay previously granted to discharged members on their return to Australia, and places them on the same basis as members who have not yet been discharged.

Sustenance Allowance.

- (a) Sustenance Allowance at the rate of 3/- per day is payable for the full number of days' leave to which a member is entitled under (a), (b), and (c) above for his period of service abroad. No deduction of 14 days is made in the payment of Sustenance Allowance, as this allowance has only recently been introduced.

4. The above gratuity is not payable to men who were returned to Australia for disciplinary reasons, other than V.D.

5. In the case of men who have returned to Australia during their period of service or who have re-enlisted, only the period of service abroad counts as service for the gratuity.

6. Members who have been granted their period of long service leave and sustenance allowance whilst serving abroad are not entitled to any payment under the above scale.

7. Declarations, when completed and witnessed, should be forwarded to the SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE, MELBOURNE.

8. If you change your address after forwarding this declaration, notify your new address to the Secretary immediately.

9. Payment will be made by Money Order which will be posted to you and will be payable at the Post Office named by you. Payment can only be made at a Money Order Post Office, and if you are in doubt as to whether the Post Office indicated by you is a Money Order Office, the Postmaster will advise you.

YOUR DISCHARGE CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRODUCED TO THE POSTMASTER WITH THE MONEY ORDER BEFORE PAYMENT CAN BE MADE.

10. PAYMENT WILL BE MADE AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE, BUT OWING TO THE LARGE NUMBER OF CLAIMS THAT WILL BE RECEIVED IT MAY BE SOME WEEKS BEFORE YOUR CLAIM IS ADJUSTED.
